Contention on Reply No. 1	Partial information provided, as CPIO provided only certified copy of merit lists but did not provided list issued after the trade test.
Comment/Remarks	In query no. 1 of your original RTI application, you had asked to provide certified copies of all merit list issued. In response you have already been provided merit list prepared after written test and after trade test. In your original RTI application you had not asked to provide list of candidates called for Personal Interview based on the performance in Written Test and trade test. Hence, reply given by CPIO was appropriate and in the spirit of RTI Act, 2005. However the list of candidates called for Personal Interview depending upon the performance and caste category is attached at Annexure 'A'.
Contention on Reply No. 4	Partial information provided, as CPIO provided only certified copy of merit lists but did not provided list as per reservation for General, Other Backward Class, Schedule Caste, Schedule Tribe and Person with Disability.
Comment/Remarks	The complete merit list revealing the caste has already been provided. Candidates getting marks above cut off for each category in the common merit list were called for personal interview. Hence, reply given by CPIO was appropriate and in the spirit of RTI Act, 2005. However the list of candidates called for Personal Interview depending upon the performance and caste category is attached at Annexure 'A'.
Contention on Reply No. 9	CPIO did not provided certified copy of reservation norms followed by IIT Jodhpur.
Comment/Remarks	IIT Jodhpur is following Government of India orders, circulars, rules regarding reservation and do not have its own orders etc.. The same are available on Department of Personnel & Training website on http://dopt.gov.in/notifications/oms-and-orders at S. No. 11. As per the various CIC and Court orders, information which are available on any public domain are not liable to be answered under RTI Act.

Comment / Remarks	<p>The CPIO had provided the fee structure for the semester <i>July 2018, December 2018 and July 2019</i> except <i>December 2019</i> of M. Tech. Program; as the <i>semester fee</i> for <i>December 2019</i> was not approved by the <i>Competent Authority</i>.</p> <p>Now, it has been approved and as per your request, the semester fee for December 2019 of M. Tech. The fellowship in the slab after 2 years of research experience may be provided after successful assessment by the Review Committee.

2.3 Such revision in rates would also be applicable to other Government and Government Aided Institutions funded by AICTE and UGC. However, no salary grant or any other salary grant would be given to any of the Institutes for implementing the Scheme.

2.4 Sponsored and Self-Financed Category of students including those in receipt of any other similar assistantship/scholarship/fellowship would not be eligible for assistantship/scholarship/fellowship under the revised scheme. Further, the assistantship/scholarship/fellowship would be provided to the scholars on the basis of GATE scores above the prescribed cut-off level. B.Tech. Graduates from the IITs getting a CGPA score of 8 or above (on scale of 10) would also be entitled to the assistantship without having to appear in GATE.

2.5 The stipend of research fellow/associate is exempted from the payment of income tax under Section 10(16) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

3. **Service Conditions:**

3.1 **DA and CCA:** JRFs, SRFs and M.E./M.Tech/MS/M.Des will not be entitled to these allowances.

3.2 **House Rent Allowance (HRA):** All research fellows and M.E./M.Tech/MS/M.Des may be provided hostel accommodation wherever available and those residing in accommodation provided by the Institute will not be eligible for drawing HRA. Wherever provision of hostel accommodation is not possible, HRA may be allowed to JRF, SRF as per Central Government norms applicable in the city/location where they are working. The fellowship amount may be taken as basic for calculating the HRA.

3.3 **Leave and other entitlement benefits:** The JRFs, SRFs and M.E./M.Tech/MS/M.Des are eligible only for casual leave. Participation of any of these categories in any scientific event/workshop in India or abroad will be treated as 'Duty'. The travel entitlement for JRF/SRF/ M.E./M.Tech/MS/M.Des for participation in scientific events/workshops in India will continue to be same as earlier, i.e. 2nd AC by rail. Maternity Leave as per Government of India instructions issued from time to time would be available to female candidates in all categories.

3.4 **Bonus and Leave Travel Concessions:** JRFs and SRFs and M.E./M.Tech/MS/M.Des will not be entitled to these allowances.

3.5 **Retirement Benefits:** JRFs, SRFs and M.E./M.Tech/MS/M.Des will not be entitled to these benefits.

4. **Publication/Patent:** The results of JRF/SRF/M.E./M.Tech/ MS/M.Des research work may be published in standard referred journals at the discretion of the Fellow or his Guide. It should be ensured by the Fellow that the assistance provided by the funding agency of Government of India is acknowledged in all such publications.

5. **Encouragement for pursuing higher degrees:** Students selected as JRF/SRF may be encouraged to register for higher degrees and the tuition fees to undertake these studies may be reimbursed to the students from the contingency grant sanctioned under the project grant, if required.

6. **Obligations of JRF/SRF:**


- (i) He/She shall be governed by the disciplinary regulations of the host Institute where he/she is working.
- (ii) The JRF/SRF/M.E./M.Tech/ MS/M.Des must send a detailed consolidated report of the research work done during the entire period of Fellowship on completion of the tenure/resignation of the Fellowship at the earliest.

7. **Date of Effect:** The revision in emoluments comes into effect from 01.02.2015 for all categories of JRF/SRF/M.E./M.Tech/ MS/M.Des.

8. The additional cost on account of this revision may be met by the individual Institutes from out of their existing budgetary grant without any additionality in the current financial year, 2014-15. During the next financial year, 2015-16, the expenditure on this account may be capped at the current year's level and also within the given allocation, without any additionality.

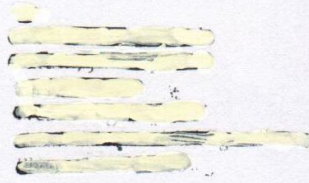

My request for the required documents and information has been rejected by the CPIO on the ground that the information sought is voluminous and would disproportionately divert the resources of the public authority or would be detrimental to the safety or preservation of the record in question. Although no specific provision of the RTI Act has been cited in support of the decision to reject my request on the aforesaid ground, I find that the language used by the CPIO has been copied almost verbatim from Section 7(9) of the RTI Act which provides that an information shall ordinarily be provided in the form in which it is sought unless it would disproportionately divert the resources of the public authority or would be detrimental to the safety or preservation of the record in question. The decision to reject my request for information on the aforesaid ground is wholly misconceived and based on lack of understanding of the purport of Section 7(9). Section 7(9) only governs the form in which information is to be provided. It mandates that the information shall ordinarily be provided in the form in which it is sought. In terms of this provision, the requirement of furnishing the information in the desired form can be waived to furnish the information in some other form if the form in which information is desired would disproportionately divert the resources of the public authority or would be detrimental to the safety or preservation of the record in question. For example, in case of genuine difficulty in making xerox copies of certain documents, its soft copies can be provided. But Section 7(9) does not permit the public authority to deny the information by taking recourse to this section. Moreover, the CPIO has vaguely mentioned all the three situations contemplated in Section 7(9) - disproportionate diversion of resources, safety of record and preservation of record - which reveals that the provision has been cited without any basis or clarity. It is again requested that the requisite information may please be furnished urgently. In case of difficulty in making photo copies of any documents, soft copies thereof may be sent to me by eMail.
